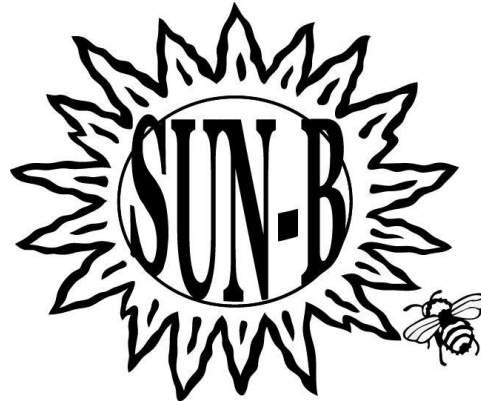
Our vision is to serve as a cohesive and efficient referral and resource network for senior services across Brooklyn

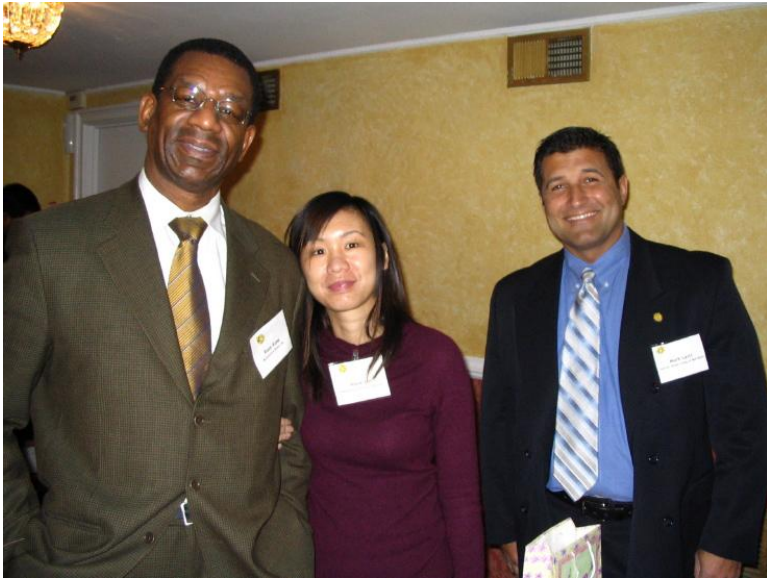
